All India Quota (AIQ) Seats under UG (BAMS/BSMS/BUMS/BHMS/B.Pharm-ITRA) Courses

and PG (MD/MS) Courses of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homoeopathy (ASU&H) for A.Y. 2024-25

- All the eligible candidates who qualified for NEET (UG)-2024 and AIAPGET-2024 examinations and aspiring for admission in Undergraduate (BAMS/BSMS/BUMS/BHMS/B.Pharm-ITRA) courses and Post Graduate (MD/MS) courses, respectively, are hereby informed that the AACCC UG/PG Counseling 2024 for allotment of AIQ- UG/PG seats of ASU&H-UG/PG courses will be held tentatively for UG from 28th August, 2024 and for PG from 1st week of September. 2024 as per schedule which will be uploaded on AACCC website (https://aaccc.gov.in)
- AACCC, M/o Ayush shall conduct counseling for admission in AIQ seats of ASU&H-UG/PG courses under Government/Government Aided College/Institute, National Institutes, Central Universities and Deemed Universities (established under Central Act).
- The counseling for admission to AIQ seats of UG & PG courses in Private Institutes of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homoeopathy shall be conducted by the respective counseling authority of the State/UT Government.
- For participation in AACCC UG/PG Counseling 2024, the candidates are required to register themselves at the official website of AACCC (https://aaccc.gov.in)
- Kindly note that 'Non-Refundable registration fees' and 'Refundable Security Deposit' have to be paid by the candidates at the time of registration as per their category and selection of counseling on the portal
- For allotment of AIQ-UG&PG seats under ASU&H stream under Government/Government aided Institutes/Colleges, National Institutes, Central Universities, AACCC, M/o Ayush will conduct four rounds of counseling through online mode: i.e. Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 and Stray Vacancy Round (Phase I & Phase II allotment)

	Phase-II:- No registration and choice filling in SVR-II. Choices locked by candidates in SVR-I shall be
	exercised as per merit and preference for phase II allotment on non-reported seats of SVR-I. After the
	SVR-II result publication, one must join the allotted seat or else counseling fees shall be forfeited & will
	become ineligible for further AACCC/State/UT counseling

- For admission to all Deemed Universities both Government and Private (established under Central Act), the AACCC, M/o Ayush shall conduct 04 (four) rounds of counseling through online mode: i.e. Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 and Stray Vacancy Round. Further, seats that remain vacant under Deemed Universities after the completion of 3rd Round of AACCC-UG/PG counseling will be reverted to respective Deemed Universities for online Stray Vacancy Round through the AACCC portal. Only registered eligible candidates on the AACCC-UG/PG portal for Deemed Universities are eligible to participate in the SVR-DU.
