


// Notice //

As you are Regt. No. 120461824 CT (GD) Ankit Kumar S/o Sh. Chetram Singh "D" Coy 55th Bn Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, absent from extra ordinary leave without prior permission/information of the competent authority on 21.05.2024 (FN). You were directed to report for duty immediately vide 55th Bn Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force Office Memorandum No. 3994 dated 22.05.2024, 4132 dated 03.06.2024 and 4131-34 dated 13.06.2024, but neither did you report for duty nor has the battalion received any information from you.

2. On your continuous absence, a letter No. 518-22 dated 22.06.2024 was sent to the Superintendent of Police, District- J.P. Nagar (Uttar Pradesh) to arrest you and hand over to 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn ITBP or 55<sup>th</sup> Bn. A copy of which was communicated to the Station House Officer, Police Station- Hasanpur, Distt- J.P Nagar(Uttar Pradesh), and also to your father with a request to direct you to return to duty immediately, but neither did you return to duty nor did the Superintendent of Police, District- J.P Nagar(Uttar Pradesh) handed over you to 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn ITBP or 55<sup>th</sup> Bn ITBP. In view of the continuous absence without prior permission/information of the competent authority from 21.05.2024(FN), a COI committee was constituted to find out the circumstances of your continued absence vide this office order No. 1747 dated 02.07.2024, under sub-section (1) of Section 74 of the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force Act, 1992. According to the findings and recommendations of the Court of Inquiry, under the provisions of sub-section (2) of Section 74 of the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force Act, 1992, you have been declared '**Deserter**' vide this office order No. 4993-5007 dated 27.07.2024. Therefore, it is considered that you are not willing to service further in the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force.

3. As per the provisions of Indo- Tibetan Border Police Force Act 1992 and Rules 1994, before further action is taken in this matter, you are being provided an opportunity to report to the Battalion Headquarters, 55<sup>th</sup> Bn, Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, Rangamati, Tezpur (Assam) within 30 days of the issue of this notice. In case of non-compliance, your services will be terminated from the Force on the grounds of unsuitability.
