WHEREAS the Petition under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, above-mentioned, along with an application for **STAY APPLICATION, APPLICATION FOR SUBSTITUTION, SUBSTITUTED SERVICE** seeking transfer of HMA No. 76 of 2017 titled as "RAMESH CHAND Vs. SEEMA", pending before the Family Court CHANDIGARH , CHANDIGARH , under the jurisdiction of High Court of CHANDIGARH , to the Family Court/Competent Court at UNA , HIMACHAL PRADESH , under the jurisdiction of the High Court of HIMACHAL PRADESH [Copy enclosed] filed by **Mr. DEEPAK GOEL**, Advocate for the petitioner was listed for preliminary hearing before this Court on **23.01.2021** and the Court passed the following order:

" Issue Notice.

In the meanwhile, further proceedings in the HMA Case No.76 of 2017 titled as 'Ramesh Chand Vs. Seema', pending before the learned District Judge, UT, Chandigarh, shall remain stayed. "

AND WHEREAS, the matter above-mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Judge in Chamber on **10th May, 2024**, when the following order was passed:

" **Learned counsel for the petitioner states that although earlier an application had been filed for issuance of substituted service by way of publication but because of the fact that one of the newspaper which was mentioned in that application was not on the panel of Directorate of Advertising and Visual Publicity (DAVP), the orders could not be complied.**

Now a request has been made for publication in Dainik Jagran (Hindi) and the Time of India (English).

Let the needful now be done within four weeks. Thereafter affidavit and proof of service through substituted mode is submitted in the Registry within a further period of two weeks. "

NOW, THEREFORE, TAKE NOTICE that the above petition along with application for stay will be taken up by this Court in due course and you may enter appearance before this Court either in-person or through an Advocate-on-Record of this Court duly appointed by you in that behalf within thirty days from the date of publication of notice. You may thereafter show cause to the Court on the day that may subsequently be specified as to why the prayer made in the transfer petition and application for stay may not be allowed/granted to the petitioner above named.



You may file your affidavit in opposition to the petition as provided under Rule 3 Order XLI, S.C.R. 2013, not later than one week before the date appointed for hearing of the petition.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that if you fail to enter appearance, as aforesaid, no further notice shall be given to you and the matter above mentioned shall be disposed of in your absence.
