6 Laning Pune - Hyderabad (Sangareddy X Road - Madinaguda) section of NH-65 (Length 30 km | Cost: ₹ 1300 Crore)

4 Lane of Kandi - Ramsanpalle section of NH-161 (Length 40 km | Cost: ₹ 1540 Crore)
