<b>Component – I</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students belonging to SC category</li> <li>Parents'/Guardians' annual income not exceeding Rs 2.50 Lakhs</li> <li>Students studying in class 9 and 10 in recognised schools</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Academic allowance ranging from Rs. 3500 to Rs. 7000 per annum</li> <li>10% extra allowance for Divyang (specially abled) students</li> </ul>
<b>Component – II</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students whose parents/guardians are engaged in occupations involving cleaning and prone to health hazards</li> <li>No income limit criteria</li> <li>Students studying in classes 1 to 10 in recognised schools</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Academic allowance ranging from Rs. 3500 to Rs. 8000 per annum</li> <li>10% extra allowance for Divyang (specially abled) students</li> </ul>

<b>POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP</b>	
<b>Eligibility</b>	<b>Entitlement</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parents'/Guardians' annual income not exceeding Rs 2.5 Lakhs</li> <li>Students pursuing courses in recognised Schools/Colleges</li> <li>All recognised courses from class 11 onwards</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Compulsory non-refundable fees (including tuition fee)</li> <li>Academic allowance ranging from Rs. 2500 to Rs. 13500 per annum</li> <li>10% extra allowance for Divyang (specially abled) students</li> </ul>

- Students should have valid Mobile Number, Aadhaar (UID) Number, Aadhaar Seeded Bank Account, Income Certificate and Caste Certificate
